Judge Angela Robinson has been an Administrative Law Judge with the D.C. Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) since February 2022. Prior to joining OAH, Judge Robinson served as a Hearing Examiner for the D.C. Child and Family Services Agency for ten years. From 2005 to 2022 Judge Robinson also ran her own firm representing parties in litigation, mediation, and administrative actions. Prior to starting her practice, Judge Robinson was an Associate at Morgan, Lewis & Bockius LLP with an international patent prosecution, licensing and litigation practice, and at Beveridge & Diamond, P.C., with an

environmental and land use practice.

Judge Robinson has been active in the D.C. Bar, Greater Washington Area Chapter of the Women Lawyers Division of the National Bar Association (GWAC), Maryland State Bar Association, and Giles S. Rich Inn of Court for the Federal Circuit. An adoptive and foster parent herself, Judge Robinson also has volunteered with the Children's Law Center in guardianship and custody matters. She also is a member of the D.C. Court of Appeals, Maryland Court of Appeals, U.S. Federal District Court for the District of Columbia and the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office.

Prior to obtaining her law degree, Judge Robinson was a Civil Engineer for 10 years working in commercial construction management and environmental consulting.
