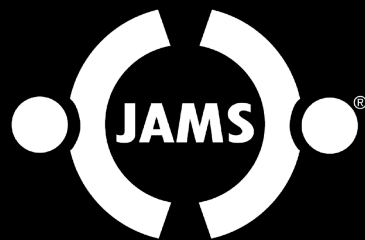

- Substantial Civil Case Work
 - Focus on civil cases or family law
- Settlement Experience
- Gaining Experience with Court Mediation or similar programs

- Common Ethical Dilemmas Faced by Arbitrators and Mediators
 - Conflicts of interest
